# Timber Frame Intensives I & II

**Two sessions**

**June 23-25, 2017 and/or July 7-9, 2017**

9am- 5pm each day---Camping available on the farm-- Hotel 15 min away---\$255 tuition each session (healthy meals add \$35)—outhouse—hot outdoor shower— no pressure work environment— free camaraderie —

*Jump right into the construction of a 2 story 600 sq/ft timber frame studio on the farm designed to complement our expanding programs.*

*Learn the fundamentals of design and construction on the job while you cut mortises and tenons. Layout techniques will be introduced as well as tool use and cutting methods.*

This 3-day intensive experience is physically demanding and requires heavy lifting and strenuous hammer work. Most tools are provided but participants are welcome to bring their own saws, mallets, and chisels (free sharpening tutorials!).

Image to the right is NOT the structure (we finished that one) but design is similar. A hammer beam truss assembly sits atop reclaimed 8x10 oak posts supported by 4x8” oak braces connecting 6x10” pine and oak girts.
